A coin identification opportunity
for young learners











Roll those Coins



Roll the Coin die (or Pull a Coin from a bag). Place a game piece on a space on the gameboard that matches with the die. If you roll a Penny, you can put a game piece on a Penny, one cent, the word Penny or 1¢. Keep rolling until you have placed a game piece on every space.

For a whole class version of this game, create a large board from a shower curtain liner. Tape off sections. Fill sections with cards depicting the different ways to show the 4 coins, including the coin, the name of the coin, the symbol for the value, and the words for the value. You may duplicate some of the cards. Tape some large coin pics onto a foam die. Have kids take turns rolling and covering.
