The IEP Meeting:

1. Ask families how they would like to provide input and give feedback related to the development of the IEP.
2. Design the meeting environment to allow for comfort and engagement.
3. Keep the focus on the child - his/her strengths, motivations and goals.

The IEP Goals:

1. Develop goals that help students develop **skills or strategies** that will lead to increased independence and expert learning.
2. Ensure that every team member who is engaging with the learner understands the goals and the services within the IEP.
3. Clearly describe the specially designed instruction the student requires to meet her unique needs.
