Task Analysis Checklist use:

- Check off the skills that each student can successfully demonstrate beginning on the right side and work toward the grade level standard
- -Plot each student's skills until the point at which they can no longer perform the skills this is their baseline
- -Skills to the left of each student's baseline must be taught
- -Assistive Technology can scaffold over skills to the left of the student's baseline and in some cases can move their baseline closer to the standard
