

Example Preference and Reinforcement Survey Grid

Directions for Use

Using the blank grid squares, insert images, symbols, or words that represent different preferences and potential reinforcers.

Once the grid is filled with a variety of preferences and reinforcers, it can be used to identify what motivates the individual. The individual can indicate their top preferences by marking the items they like best in each grid square.

Options for use:

1. Print a paper copy and laminate it for use with a wet erase marker
2. Print a paper copy and put it into a clear sheet protector for use with a wet erase marker
3. Mark and share the document electronically
